Be It Resolved by the Township Trustees of Blendon Township

WHEREAS, The Blendon Township Board of Trustees recognize for the public good, artificial street lighting must be maintained in the Sunbury Woods subdivision, and continuous areas, Blendon Township, Trustee Welch moved for the adoption of the resolution. Trustee Flaherty seconded the motion.

All of the lots and parcels of land in Sunbury Woods Subdivision and contiguous areas will continue to be part of the Sunbury Woods Street Lighting Project; and,

Resolution 2019-08 incorrectly established the lighting assessment rates at \$25.00 per lot, per year; where the existing established per lot, per year assessment is \$49.00; and,




Resolution 2019-08 is hereby corrected to reflect the correct assessment of \$49.00 per lot, per year; and,

The Fiscal Officer of Blendon Township will certify to the Franklin County Auditor that assessment of \$49.00 per lot, per year, to be levied against each numbered lot in the above listed subdivision, Blendon Township; and,

The Fiscal Officer will certify that the assessment is to apply for a period of three years, beginning on January 1, 2020, and ending on December 31, 2022, and the first collection of assessment will be made with the taxes due the first half of 2020.
