Resolution by the Blendon Township Board of Trustees:

To authorize Franklin Soil and Water Conservation District (Franklin Soil and Water) to apply and accept assistance from the Clean Ohio Conservation Fund administered through the Ohio Public Works Commission.

Whereas, the Ohio Public Works Commission has grants available from the Clean Ohio Conservation Program Fund for the preservation of open spaces, sensitive ecological areas, and stream corridors; and

Whereas, it is in the best interest of Franklin Soil and Water to take advantage of the opportunities provided by this program by applying for the funding for the Capitol City Baptist Church Wetland Project in Blendon Township.
