Police Levy

Be It Resolved by the Township Trustees of **Blendon** Township

that the **TRUSTEES** recognize it is necessary to levy 5.75 mills for the Police District (unincorporated portion of Blendon Township), for the purpose of providing and maintaining motor vehicles, communications, and other equipment used directly in the operation of a police department, in the operation of a police department, or the payment of salaries of permanent police personnel, including the payment of the policemen employer’s contribution required under Section 742.33 of the Revised Code, or the payment of the costs incurred by township as a result of contracts and with other political subdivisions in order to obtain police protection, or to provide ambulance or emergency medical services operated by a police department; which levy is a new levy of 5.75 mills, and that such levy be submitted to the voters at the General Election in March 2016, per Section 5705.19 of the Ohio Revised Code.

THEREFORE, IT IS REQUESTED THAT THE County Auditor certify to the Blendon Township Trustees, the total current tax valuation and the amount of revenue that would be generated by the new 5.75 mills levy.
