Roll Call: Mrs. Heichel, here; Mr. Flaherty, here; Mr. Smith, here; Mr. Welch, here. Administrator Rhoads, Chief Miller, and Chief Belford were also in attendance.

The regular meeting of the Blendon Township Board of Trustees was called to order at 6:30pm.

Minutes - July 07 Minutes- Mr. Welch asked if the board was able to review the minutes for July 07, 2021. Mr. Flaherty moved to approve the minutes and waive the formal reading. Mrs. Heichel seconded. All voted yes.

The new section will cost \$950 per resident and \$1950 per non-resident. The old section pricing will remain the same. Mr. Flaherty moved to approve the request as presented and Mrs. Heichel seconded. All voted yes.

1. **Trash Consortium-** Mr. Rhoads updated the board about the consortium bidding process. Official contract documents will be ready for adoption at the next meeting.

Director/Staff Updates- Chief Belford updated the board about police statistics and the board had some discussion about the newly deployed body camera system. Fire Chief Miller advised the board about installing smoke detectors in homes. Their program is back up and running. Trustee Heichel mentioned the recent success of the park concert. The event was heavily attended, and the weather was perfect.

Open Floor- Mrs. Delana Ciamacco, 4531 East Walnut Street- Mrs. Ciamacco asked about the smoke detector program and replacement of the cemetery position. Mrs. Carolyn Cordray, 3734 Caracas Drive updated the board about National Night Out. Mrs. Pam Clegg, 3614 Makassar- Advised the board about Blendon Blooms.
