Roll Call: Mr. Smith, here. Mrs. Heichel, here. Mr. Welch, here. Mr. Flaherty, here. Administrator Rhoads, Fire Chief Brian Miller, and Chief Belford were also in attendance.

The regular meeting of the Blendon Township Board of Trustees was called to order at 6:30pm.

Minutes - October 13 Minutes- Mr. Welch asked if the board was able to review the minutes for October 13, 2021. Mr. Flaherty moved to approve the minutes and waive the formal reading. Mrs. Heichel seconded. All voted yes.

Administrators Report – Mr. Rhoads updated the board on a variety of topics including COVID grants, FOP negotiations, and a notice from Genoa Township about a new Hoover watershed overlay.

New Business

1. **Franklin County DUI Contract-** Chief Belford asked the board to approve the 2022 contract with Franklin County for the DUI Task Force. Mr. Flaherty moved to approve the resolution and Mrs. Heichel seconded. All voted yes.
2. **Glengary Center JEDZ Grant-** Mr. Rhoads asked the board to approve a \$25,000 JEDZ grant to assist the Glengary Center with paving. The area paved is the path from Brazzaville Road to Westerville Road which is heavily used by residents. Mr. Flaherty motioned to approve as presented and Mrs. Heichel seconded. All voted yes.
3. **Resolution NU-06-21-** Mr. Rhoads requested the board pass resolution NU-06-21 for high grass at 4200 Bitterroot Drive. Mr. Flaherty motioned to approve the resolution and Mrs. Heichel seconded. All voted yes.
4. **Resolution 2021-II** – Mr. Smith requested the board pass resolution 2021-11 which accepts and appropriates \$417,171.10 into a newly created fund 2903 called the American Rescue Plan Act Coronavirus Relief Fund. Mr. Flaherty motioned to approve, and Mrs. Heichel seconded. All voted yes.

Old Business

1. Mr. Flaherty advised the board and audience that the township is still looking at options for the new facility to house employees. Soaring costs right now are playing a major role with planning.

Director/Staff Updates- Trustee Heichel advised the board about the 2022 township calendar contest. We are hopeful to have the final version by the next meeting. We had over 330 entries. Chief Belford advised the board that officers are ready to patrol for the upcoming trick-or-treat.

Open Floor – Delana Ciamacco, 4531 E. Walnut Street, asked Mr. Rhoads to email her the information about the Genoa Township overlay. Carolyn Cordray, 3734 Caracas Drive, updated the board about the successful trunk-or-treat event. The event was organized by a few volunteers in the community and the turnout was great.


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Bills- Mr. Flaherty motioned to pay the bills. Mrs. Heichel seconded. All voted yes.
